

TAX BILLS INTRODUCED MARCH 7TH:

1. [110th] H.R.1365 : To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to repeal the alternative minimum tax on corporations.

Sponsor: Rep English, Phil [PA-3] (introduced 3/7/2007) Cosponsors (10)

2. [110th] H.R.1366 : To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to repeal the alternative minimum tax on individuals.

3. [110th] H.R.1367 : To amend section 712 of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, section 2705 of the Public Health Service Act, and section 9812 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to require equity in the provision of mental health and substance-related disorder benefits under group health plans.

4. [110th] H.R.1377 : To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide a credit against tax for an individual teaching in a school with a significant number of limited English proficient students and to provide a deduction for expenses paid or incurred by a teacher for courses required for certification in teaching English as a second language.

5. [110th] H.R.1378 : To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow individuals to designate any portion of a refund for use by the Secretary of Health and Human Services in providing catastrophic health coverage to individuals who do not otherwise have health coverage.
