**INTRODUCTION**

At the federal level, members of Congress are introducing and considering legislation that recognizes the promise and dangers posed by artificial intelligence (AI), across a variety of sectors. Below, you will find brief summaries of active federal legislation related to AI. The document is divided into the following sections:

- **Consumer-Facing** – Covers legislation that pertains to forgery, personal privacy, fraud, and consumer safety concerns with AI usage.
- **Developers** – Covers legislation that involves the actions of AI developers, national security, intelligence, and interactions with foreign states and actors.
- **Weather Technology** – Covers legislation that utilizes AI for weather forecasting, research, response, and communication.
- **Workplace-Facing** – Covers legislation that involves AI training and usage for businesses.
